

Ella (RGN, BSc Hons Long Term Conditions (Respiratory Pathway)) has been a Practice nurse for 15+ years focusing on long term conditions and respiratory care; she is currently working in Primary Care as a Respiratory Nurse Specialist. Her experience includes case managing long term conditions in the community as a Community Matron; leading the Wiltshire Home Oxygen and Pulmonary Rehab Service and supporting patients with complex and end stage respiratory disease as a Community Respiratory Clinical and Team Lead.

Beverley (RN, BSc, Post Dip) is a Respiratory Nurse Specialist working at Trowbridge Health Centre (THC). She leads a team of nurses and a care co-ordinator looking after 3,000 patients with Asthma, COPD, Bronchiectasis and ILD. During her 10 years she has streamlined the respiratory services by adding in complex clinics and establishing a paediatric asthma clinic. This has seen improved patient care and reductions in exacerbations. She has also been the chair of WANG for several years before passing to our current guardian Cathy Warner. She was the clinical lead across Wiltshire in the implementation of the FeNo Project in conjunction with West of England Academic Health Science Network. This saw an uptake in over 80% of Wiltshire primary care practices and helped to optimise asthma treatment in both adults and children. As an active member of the South West Respiratory Champions and has been a part of a regional group working towards optimising respiratory pathways and ensuring good liaison with secondary care. She is an effective mentor for novice respiratory nurses and has been instrumental in establishing robust respiratory service in several practices around Wiltshire over the years. She is currently working towards several QI projects with her team of nurses to improve services with regards to inhalers and managing bronchiectasis patients.

Sebastian (BM BSc (Hons) MSc PGCert MRCPCH) is a Paediatric Consultant in Salisbury with a specialist interest in Asthma and a Clinical Advisor for BSW ICB. He is also co-chair of the Paediatrics Specialist Interest Group at the British Society of Lifestyle Medicine and keen to share this novel approach for improving Asthma care for CYP.
